

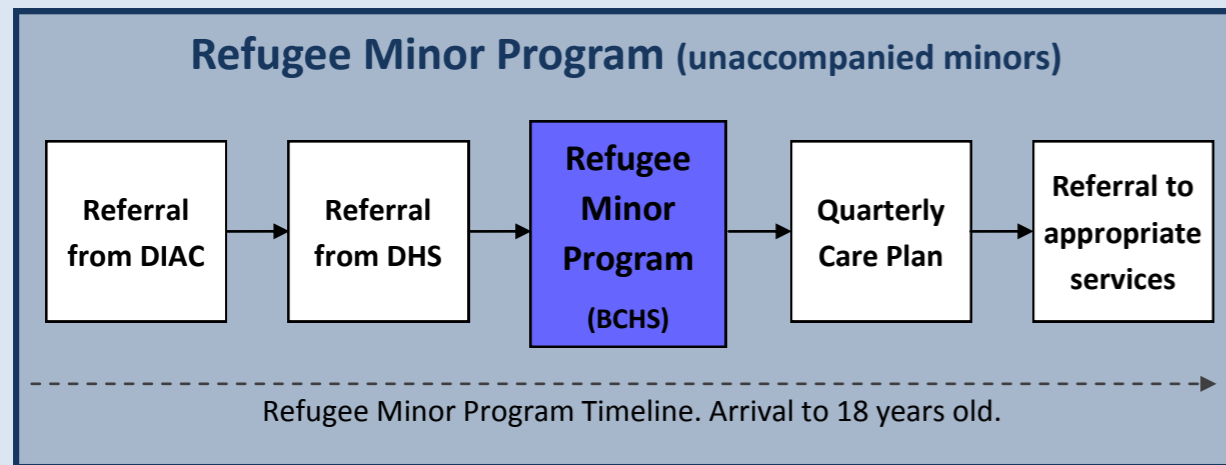
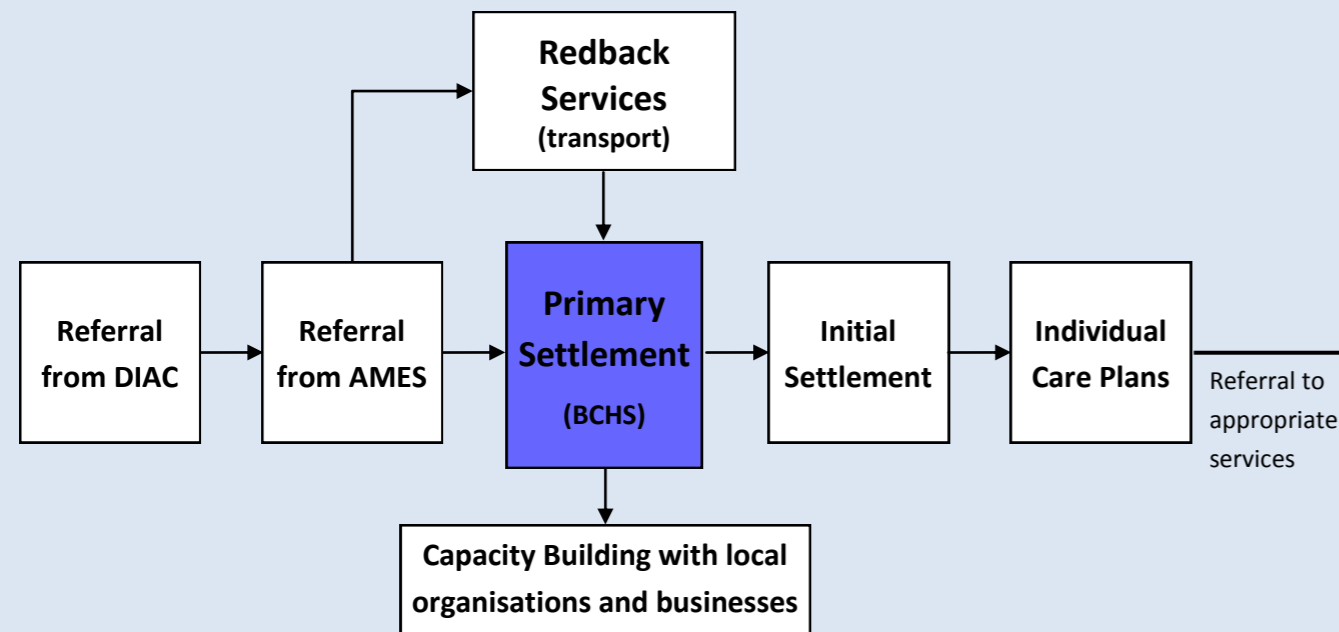
Refugee Settlement and Health Care Pathway
